

## Road Signs and Ditches Committee

**Purpose:** The purpose of the Roads, Signs, and Ditches Committee is to help ensure that all the roads, all information and regulatory signs, and road-side drainage areas are satisfactorily maintained for the welfare and beauty of the Gleneagle Civic Association (GCA) community.

**Organization:** The Committee shall consist of a voluntary Chairperson appointed by the GCA Board of Directors from among the Gleneagle residents. Other members of the Committee must come from the Gleneagle community and shall be selected by the Committee Chairperson.

**Duties:** The Committee shall perform the following activities:

1. Ensure that the painted road stripes are adequately maintained by providing active liaison with the appropriate El Paso County department.
2. Identify road deterioration, potholes, and other road problems, and communicate such problems to the appropriate El Paso County department for timely repair.
3. Identify problems and deterioration of traffic and street signs, and communicate such problems to the appropriate El Paso County department for timely repair.
4. Identify problems and deterioration of information signs, and communicate such problems to the appropriate owner of the signs for timely repair.
5. Upon approval of the GCA Board of Directors, replace broken sign poles with the standard Gleneagle wooden poles in order to sustain the tradition of Gleneagle signs.
6. Identify unsightly and problematic drainage areas along GCA roads. Problems identified will be brought to the attention of the property owner, or the appropriate El Paso County department, for resolution.

**General:** The Committee must establish a cordial working relationship with the appropriate El Paso County department, or appropriate owner, in order to maintain responsiveness to issues and items identified by the Committee. The Committee Chairperson, or designee on the Committee, should attend the monthly meetings of the GCA Board of Directors and provide a report of activities and issues to the Board.

This policy is hereby approved by a vote of the GCA Board of Directors.
